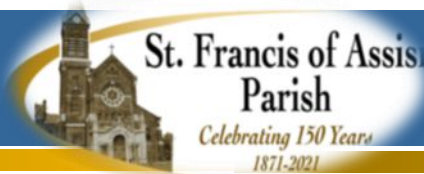
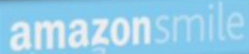

The Social Justice committee is sponsoring a donation drive for Sojourner during the month of June.

Located at 6th and Walnut Streets, just a few blocks from our parish, Sojourner is the largest nonprofit provider of domestic violence prevention and intervention services in Wisconsin, serving over 11,800 children and adults each year. Sojourner provides an array of support aimed at helping families affected by domestic violence achieve safety, justice and well-being.

As the pandemic continues, the demand for services continues to increase. Violence is more intense, unpredictable and lethal during these times of extreme stress and economic hardship. Murders committed by loved ones and partners have skyrocketed. In Milwaukee County, domestic violence-related deaths have increased by 400% in the past 2 years. It's tragic and also preventable.

Sojourner needs our assistance. Please bring any of the items listed below and place them on the altar:

BABY ITEMS: diapers, baby formula

BATHROOM ITEMS: towels, wash cloths

PERSONAL ITEMS: Shampoo (all hair types), deodorant, tooth paste, tooth brushes etc.

Ubicado en las calles 6th y Walnut, a pocas cuadras de nuestra parroquia, Sojourner la mayor organizacion sin fines de lucro de servicios de intervención y prevención de la violencia doméstica en Wisconsin, y atiende a más de 11,800 niños y adultos cada año. Sojourner brinda una variedad de apoyo destinado a ayudar a las familias afectadas por la violencia doméstica a lograr seguridad, justicia y bienestar.

▲A medida que continúa la pandemia, la demanda de servicios sigue aumentando. La violencia es más intensa, impredecible y letal durante estos tiempos de estrés extremo y dificultades económicas. Los asesinatos cometidos por seres queridos y parejas se han disparado. En el condado de Milwaukee, las muertes relacionadas con la violencia doméstica han aumentado en un 400% en los últimos 2 años. Es trágico y también prevenible.
