

Guns are the leading cause of death for US children and teens, since surpassing car accidents in 2020. Firearms accounted for nearly **19%** of childhood deaths *(ages 1-18) in 2021*. Nearly 3,600 children died in gun-related incidents that year. That's about five children lost for every 100,000 children in the United Statesss. In no other comparable country are firearms within the top four causes of mortality among children.

The shooting at *The Convenant School in Nashville* on Monday March 27th, marks the 16th shooting this year in grades K-12 and the deadliest since the school shooting in Uvalde, Texas, last year.

Six people - three children and three aduts were killed.

There have been 130 mass shootings so far in 2023.
