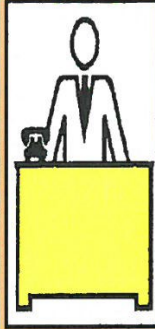
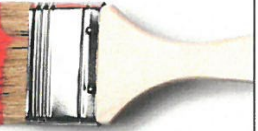

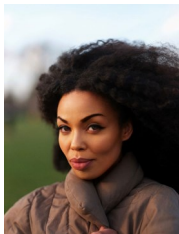

Checota Scholarships - provides a FULL RIDE for those pursuing one of 90 trade or technical programs. Tuition, books/materials, transportation, childcare, food & housing support. Once awarded, students keep the scholarship by maintaining a 2.0 GPA and taking at least 9 credits a semester. Application includes completing a FAFSA or an alternate form for DACA students. Promise Scholarships - provides free tuition for up to 75 credits. There is a Promise scholarship for recent HS grads (including HSED/GED grads) and an **Adult Promise** for those returning to school.
