

Plenary Indulgence Indulgencia Plenaria



This year we are able to receive a plenary indulgence from Dec. 8, the solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, to Feb. 2, 2024, the feast of the Presentation of Our Lord Jesus Christ, by praying before a Nativity scene in a Franciscan church. This means that this indulgence can be received right here at St. Francis! A plenary or "full" indulgence is a special type of indulgence that, if all the requirements are met, removes all temporal punishment due to one's sin. Towards this end, our Nativity scene will remain in the church until February 2. Please share this news with your family and friends.
